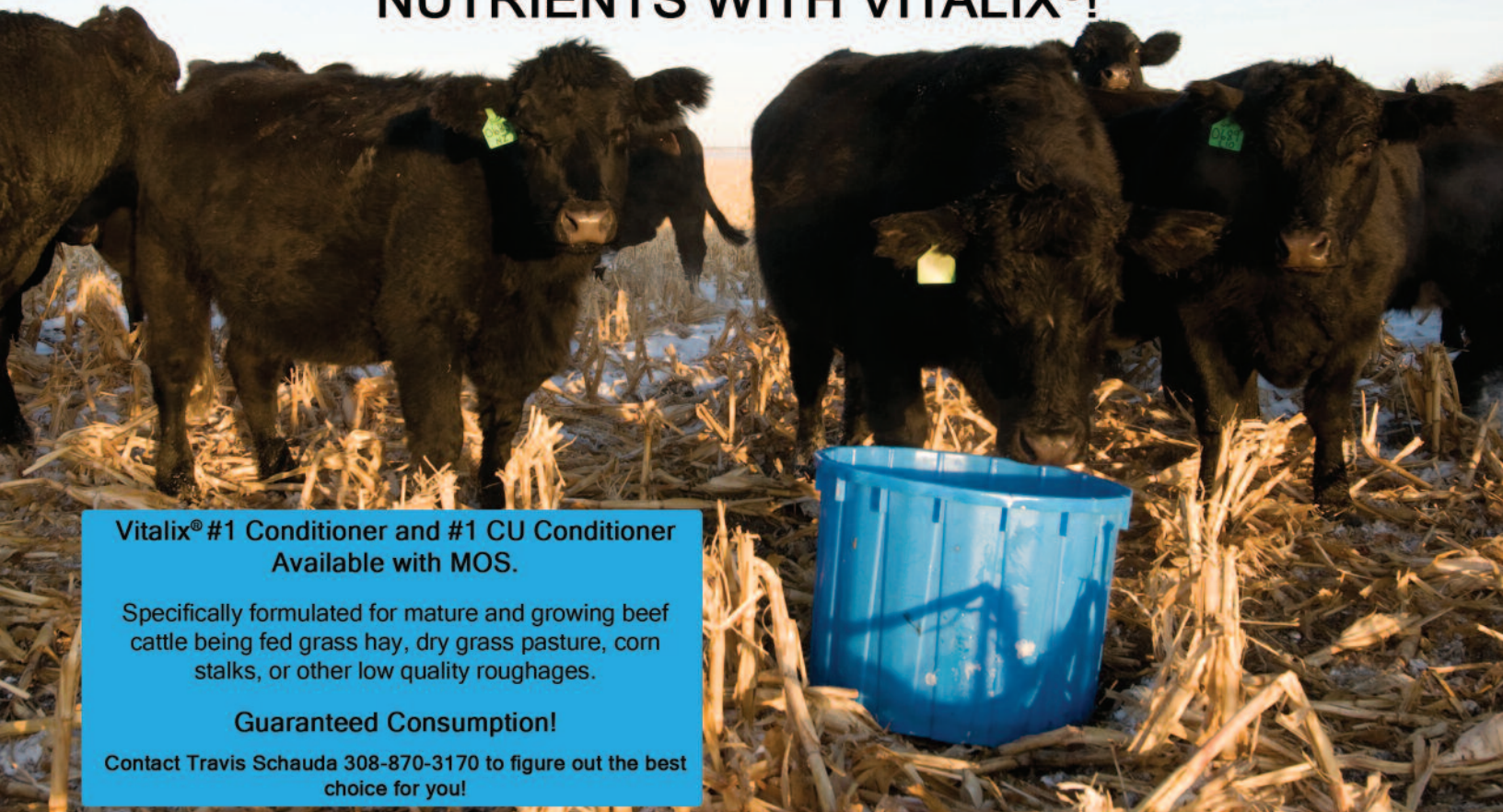

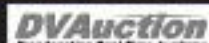

He truly loved encouraging and educating young cattlemen and women and enjoyed his time as an advisor for multiple junior associations. Sam was also a strong supporter of the FFA and enjoyed giving back as a former Indiana FFA officer himself.

Sam will be remembered as a man of honor, as proud as he was humble, and as strong as he was kind. He loved his family fiercely and would do anything for a friend. He was a pursuer of his passions and believed in hard work and continuous learning. He valued his friendships more than
