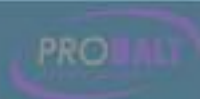

Dear Nebraska Angus Friends,

Angus Link has expanded!

Angus Link (AL) is not only the Genetic Merit Scorecard that provides valuable information about your calves to potential buyers, it is now also a **USDA Process Verified Program (PVP)**. Listed below are brief descriptions of the various programs and certifications that are available to participants.

Angus Link representatives now have the ability to certify **Age & Source**. These animals will have been traced to the ranch of origin and have calving records to document the first calf born on premises. Required will be program compliant RFID tags, or Matched Pair Set AngusLink tags.

Non-Hormone Treated Cattle (NHTC) applies to cattle who have not received any added hormone growth promotants (HGP) during their lives. An onsite review will be conducted prior to the calves leaving the ranch of origin.

Enrollment in **AL-NeverEver3 (NE3)** is combined with NHTC verification and therefore is not a stand-alone program. In addition to NHTC status, animals cannot have received any antibiotics or animal by-products during their lives. Again, documentation may be required.

AL-Angus Sired Genetics – This is a basic program that verifies and documents that enrolled calves are 50% Angus. Sires used must be registered and transferred Angus bulls, used either by AI or natural service.

To verify animal health practices, **AL-Calf Management** is available. This is an add-on, optional certification to another program.



Further, **AL-Cattle Care & Handling** can be utilized in conjunction with Age & Source verification. This requires an onsite review, as well as current BQA certification. This is desired by some buyers to assure proper management techniques and a commitment to beef industry quality.

Finally, the **Genetic Merit Scorecard**, the original cornerstone of Angus Link, is still available to illustrate the quality of the feeder cattle being marketed. These scores are the result of your registered and transferred bull battery, and consist of the Beef Score, Feedlot Score, and Grid Score.

All Angus Link programs are for the benefit of commercial producers. They are tangibles that help producers differentiate their calves from the masses, and market the quality of their genetics and onsite practices.

We all benefit from the successful sale of calves that have been sired by registered Angus bulls.

More information is available on the AAA website under Angus Link, or by calling the office in St Joseph for assistance.

We are a family owned operation by Roger and wife Karen, son Jim and wife Teresa, and their son Chet and his wife Melinda and their daughters Amaya and Bella. Roger and Karen also have a daughter Pam and husband Dan and two children Matt and Jenny, who live in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The first three registered cows were bought in 1983 from E Bar V Angus. Later cows were bought from Max Hoffmeister, Sitz Gardener, and the TC Ranch. There are 130 registered cows currently. Some of the sires represented on this year's tour are Land Grant, Ashland, Gold Rush, Innovation, and Roughrider. Our bulls are marketed at the South West Nebraska Angus Association sale and through private treaty. We look forward to having you come and see us on the Nebraska Angus Tour!

BEAR MOUNTAIN ANGUS *Focusing on Quality with Performance*

Bear Mountain Angus is a family run business owned and operated by Brian & Tiffany Stoller along with our daughters Reagan and Mckinley. We are located in Palisade, Nebraska which is about 30 minutes west of McCook, along the Frenchman Creek. We moved to this location 12 years ago from Melba, Idaho.

We have been in the Angus business since 1985, which started as a 4-H project when my parents bought

my brother and I each an Angus heifer from Thomas Angus in Baker, Oregon. We both got really involved in the Junior Angus Association in California and nationally. After college, my parents and I bought the place in Idaho which is when this became our sole business and source of income.

We have held an annual bull sale every year since 2001 along with several female sales. Currently we have two sales a year. One is the last Wednesday in January where we sell yearling and coming 2-year-old (fall born) bulls, along with a few open heifers. The other sale is the 2nd Saturday in November where we sell bred heifers and cows along with some long yearling bulls. We sell approximately 175 bulls and 150 registered females each year.

Our slogan is "Focusing on Quality with Performance." To us, this means we strive to breed cattle that are structurally sound and functional with plenty of muscle and capacity in a fairly moderate frame that still push the scale down and perform on the rail. Our bulls are developed on a high roughage, non-starch diet. By developing them this way, we believe they hold up better and last longer.

We currently run 350 Registered Angus cows. We calve about 250 in the spring (most from mid-January through mid-March) and 100 in the Fall from mid-August through September. We AI everything at least once and then run herd bulls. We also have an embryo program so we can produce more calves out of our

superior cows. By doing this, our customers can buy full brothers to put on a set of cows to have a more uniform set of calves. We produce our high-performing replacement females by flushing the best females.

We aim to run our cows a lot like our commercial customers do. The spring cows graze on corn stalks in the fall and winter-up until they calve. Then they are fed a high roughage, non-starch ration through AI time and until the grass comes (usually the first of May), and then they run on grass until the corn stalks are available. The fall cows are only fed 30 days prior to breeding, and once they are AI'd, they go to corn stalks until we wean their calves in mid-March, and then run on grass through the spring and summer. Our heifer calves are weaned on oat hay and then put back out to grass in the fall until corn stalks are available. We get them in and feed them for 45 days prior to breeding and then put them back out to grass when it's ready. By doing this we feel these cattle are thrifter.

We have been very fortunate to have many good friends and neighbors who help us when we need a little extra help. Currently, we don't have any employees, but if the right person comes along, we are definitely looking. We always appreciate visitors to our operation, and we look forward to visiting with you on this year's Nebraska Angus Tour.

RIVERSIDE RANCH *2020 Angus Tour*

Welcome to Riverside Ranch and the 2020 Nebraska Angus Tour. We are excited to help showcase Southwest Nebraska Angus Breeders and Businesses.

Riverside Ranch is a family operation located 12 miles east of McCook along the beautiful Republican River Valley. Owned and operated by Rob and Becki Lampe, along with our two children Bryn, 14 and Breyer, 12. In 2010 we had the opportunity to buy part of the KJ River Ranch, who I was

working for at the time. We now are raising and teaching our kids to respect and love this way of life.

On top of helping around our place, my wife is also a nurse at Community Hospital in McCook. She stays busy chasing our two kids around in their activities. Bryn is going into her freshman year at Southwest High School and loves to play volleyball and basketball. She keeps busy in 4-H showing her Angus heifers and show pigs. Breyer is my right-hand man and loves being outside helping me with the cowherd and driving the tractor in the hayfield whenever he can. He is going into 6th grade this fall and loves basketball and working with his Angus show heifers and show pigs.

Our herd is made up of 150 registered & commercial Black Angus cattle, 200 acres of irrigated and dryland alfalfa and 2,000 acres of pasture. We offer yearling and two year old bulls for sale by private treaty annually. We also consign bulls to the annual Southwest Nebraska Angus Association Sale every March.

We A.I. 60-70% of our cows to some of the top Angus bulls in the breed every year. This year calves are sired by Ashland, South Charm, Hombre, Cowboy Up and Connealy Armory. The cowherd sire base goes back to Sitz Upward, Final Product, New Design 878, Emblazon and Traveler based pedigrees.

I had the pleasure of working for numerous Angus operations for 30 years across the United States, Canada, Australia, England & New Zealand before I came to this part of the coun-

try. I was able to gain a lot of experience and knowledge, making lifelong friends along the way. Those experiences reflect on our accomplishments in this operation over the last 10 years.

I would like to thank our bull and hay customers for their support and friendship over the years. If it wasn't for them we wouldn't be in this business.

This year has started off as a challenging one for the world, with the current events transpiring around us. What we know though, is agriculture remains the backbone of this great nation and as always we will preserve with hard work and the encouragement of our friends and neighbors.

As Ruggles Angus began it became Jeff's family's passion and drive to breed the best angus seedstock for the commercial cattlemen. Real world cattle that will work in the Sandhills of Nebraska to the plains of Southwest Nebraska and Western Kansas or anywhere in the world. Cattle like Mill Bar Hickok, bred and sold by Mill Bar Angus in 2012 that has went on to be the #1 semen selling bull for ABS the last two years. His Dam is still doing great things in our program today. Along with the seventy-five daughters of Hickok leading our program to the next level.

In the 2020 sale our leadoff bull sold for \$35,000 to ABS. Charisma is a Confidence Plus son out of a pathfinder Upward dam. Charisma is a heifer bull that checks all the boxes with a +16 CED and a balanced set of breeds leading EPD's. We are extremely excited to see his 1st set of calves this spring.

The Ruggles Angus production sale will be held on January 22, 2021 at Tri-State Livestock in McCook Ne selling 130 yearling and 18-month-old bulls and 25 registered replacement heifers. Sires represented include Hickok, Raindance, No Doubt, Southern Charm, Abundance, McCook, Ashland, and Legend. We offer free wintering and delivery nationwide after April 1st.

The family also runs around 100 head of commercial cattle on 3500 acres with corn, wheat and milo for cash crop and stock grazing purposes.

Frontier Angus stock is calved in late winter/early spring, summered with no creep feed in the pasture, and weaned on alfalfa/cane/silage/WDG mix in the fall.

Frontier Angus has always operated as a mom and pop business with the goal of continuing to strive for repeated customer satisfaction and producing a quality performance product that is profitable for everyone.

detect and AI through a second cycle. We focus on balanced EPD's with an emphasis on genetics that produce cattle to thrive in our environment. We have marketed replacement heifers privately and through the Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic sale and we sell bulls by private treaty each year. In addition, we also run registered Sim-Angus cows and sell seedstock from this group as well.

We take pride in the fact that we have accomplished so much in our "spare time" by working hard along with our kids, Allison (17) and Nathan

(15). They have been an integral part of the operation and help with everything from feeding, calving, AI'ing, and checking water! Both kids have stepped out and purchased a few of their own replacement heifers so we are excited to see their herd grow in the future!

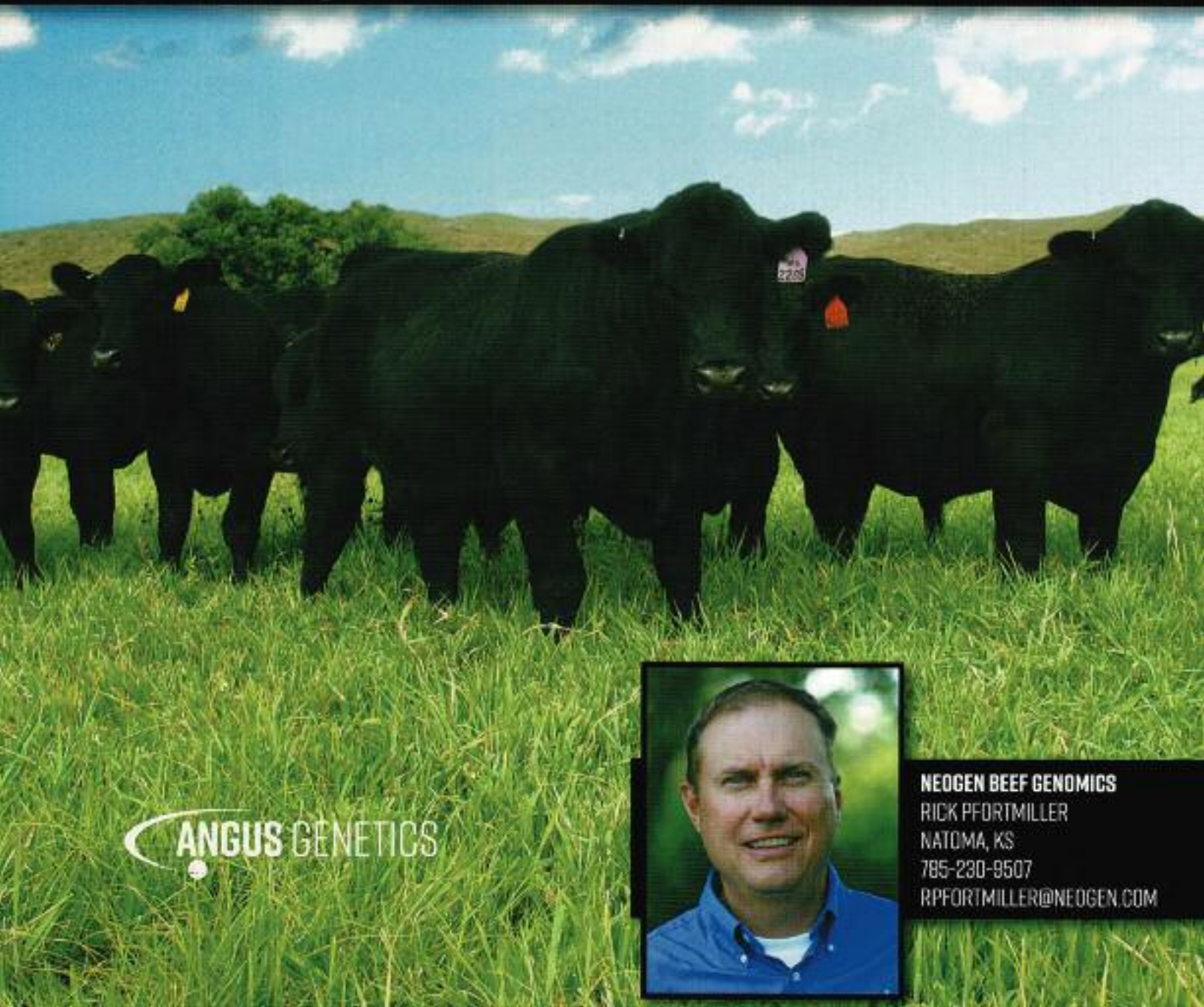
