Dear Nebraska Angus Friends,

A couple of years ago I wrote a column about the more prevalent appearance of plant based alternatives to meat that were appearing in fast food restaurants and grocery stores.

Now, I have some good news for those of us who produce, believe in, and enjoy real beef!

According to an article from Adobe Stock, by Keith Nunes, fresh and frozen plant-based meat alternative demand is decelerating after two years of strong growth. Below is a summary of the highlights.

Chris DuBois, senior Vice President of IRI's Protein Practice (a division of the big data/market performance/analytical service) stated that "Plant-based meats don't make up 50% of the market, or 25%. Despite all the noise, it's 1.5% of the meat sales." Among the reasons he cites for the decline are that these products don't meet the consumers' perception of cleanliness, and the companies have not proven that they are more sustainable than conventional meat products.

Michael H. McCain, the president and CEO of plant based protein producer Maple Leaf Foods, said in the recent quarterly sales report call with securities analysts, "In the past six months, unexpectedly, there has been a rapid deceleration in the category growth of plant-based protein. Of course, our performance has suffered in the middle of this, but the more concerning set of facts are rooted in category performance, which (has) basically flatlined. To be clear, there is a fair amount of COVID noise in the market now, and we can't discount that. However, it isn't only COVID noise, and we're going right back to square one with the consumer to fully understand what has changed, if anything, and why."

Beyond Meat, Inc. missed its third-quarter guidance of between 120-140 million in sales, and reported only 106 million. The CEO and president, Ethan Brown gave six reasons for the sales decline:

- 1) Consumers reported fewer and less frequent trips to the store
- 2) Consumers reported being less open to trying new products
- 3) Consumers reported less interest in healthy options



4) Cancellation or reduced scope of our sampling program as the Delta Variant spread - limiting new exposure to our brand

5) Labor shortages created complexity and may have impacted delay in shelf resets and less frequent stocking

6) Increased competition impacting our market share

DuBois also made the point that the decline in demand may be the labeling of these alternative products. He said, "There are a lot of different oils and complicated ingredients used in meat substitutes. When you look at the ingredient list of a McDonald's burger like the Quarter Pounder or Big Mac, it's phenomenally simpler; it reads a lot simpler than traditional plant-based meats." Further, "Plant-based meats have a nice halo when it comes to sustainability, but I have yet to see a carbon footprint on a package. There is a halo there, but I can't tell you if it's true. I personally have not seen it measured yet."

DuBois predicted that the ceiling for plant-based alternative sales would be 2% of retail meat sales. "If they simplify the ingredient list, it may be one or two percentage points higher," he stated, "but meat alternatives are going to be niche products for a long time."

I found some solace in the information above, and hope you do, too. I have wondered how folks who are so concerned about clean food could possibly think eating something grown in a Petri dish sounded like a good idea.

Of course, I'd like the analysts to just say that people tried plant-based alternatives and thought they tasted awful, but I haven't seen those data points yet.

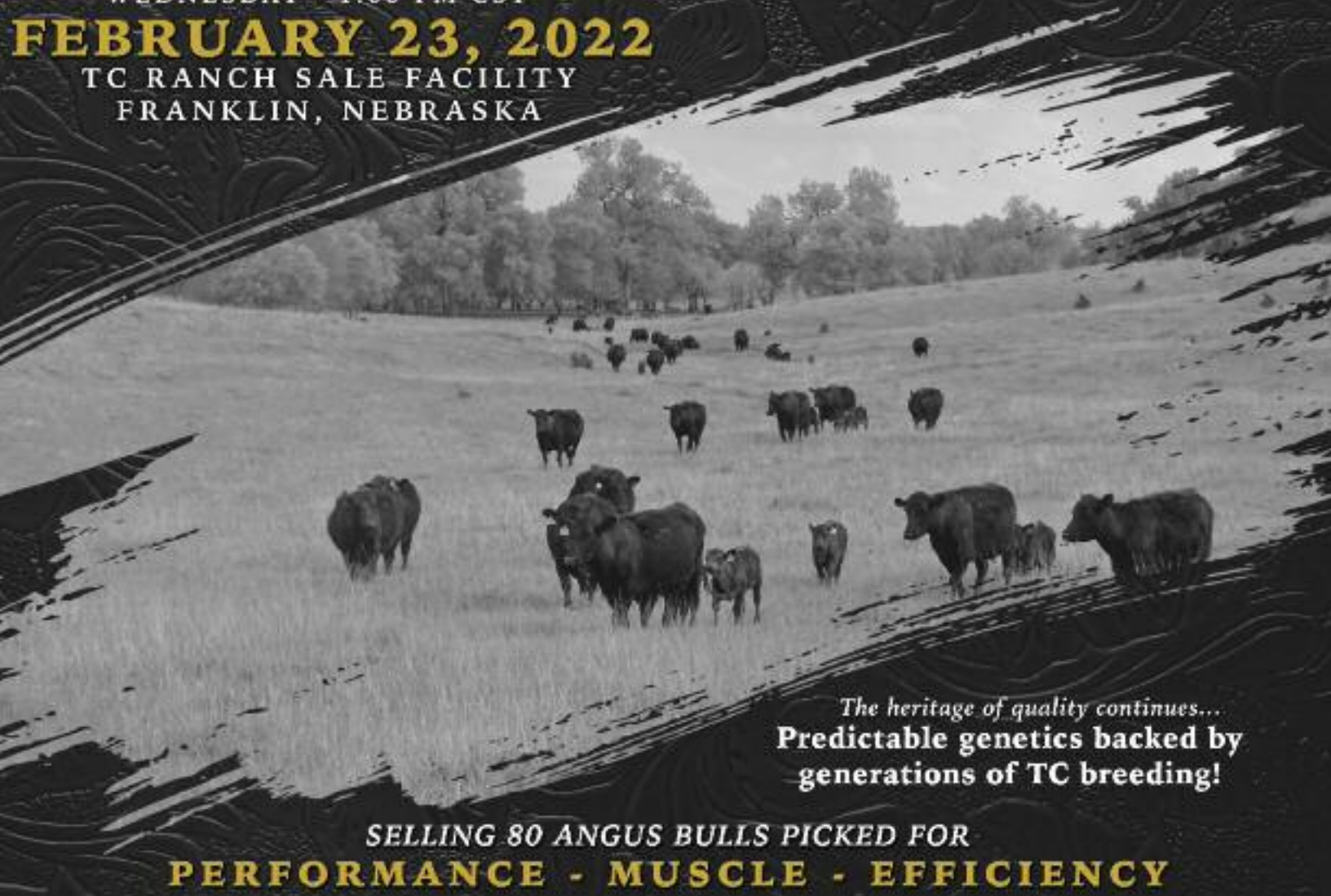

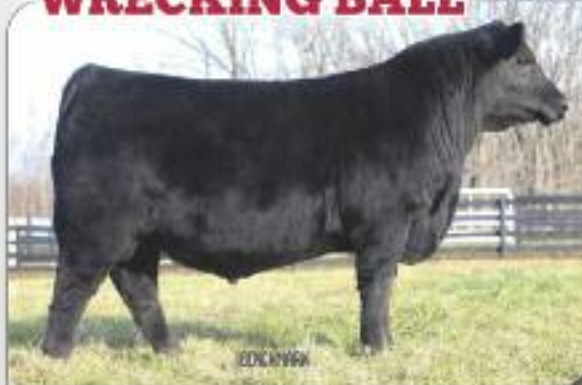

All three children are named after their grandparents with both their first and middle names. In Matt's spare time, which is very limited, he enjoys hunting, fishing, golfing, and spending time going through cattle. Besides serving on the Nebraska Angus Association board, Matt has held positions with Pheasants Forever as Vice President and has helped at the Immaculate Conception Church.

NEBRASKA PRODUCER OF THE YEAR

THE GRAY'S ANGUS RANCH

Rod and Laura Gray and family of Harrison, Nebraska, are the recipients of the 2021 Nebraska Angus Producer of the Year. Raising registered Angus has been a family tradition for the Gray's. Rod's great-great grandfather Starr Fuller had American Aberdeen Angus registries from Toledo, Iowa, dating back to 1898. Harry Gray, Rod's grandpa purchased Angus cows from his wife's father, Art Fuller and held public auctions of "Richly Bred Angus Cattle" in the 1940's. Wayne Gray, Rod's dad, built the Angus cow herd to 400 registered females and sold bulls private treaty. At the age of 15, Rod purchased his first bull from the Champion Pen of 3 at Denver, which was a son of Ankonian President. Rod grew up active in the Iowa Junior Angus Association and served as President. He showed their own Angus breeding stock in 4-H, Progress Shows, Iowa State Fair, and the Denver Stock Show.



Rod and Laura moved to Nebraska in 1983 and have raised their family in the Angus business since. Their children were active in the Nebraska Junior Angus Association. Naomi was Nebraska Angus Queen in 2000, and a finalist for Miss American Angus. Their children also showed at AKSARBEN, the National Junior Angus Show, Progress Shows and in 4-H. Rod served on the Nebraska Angus Association Board of Directors and was the 1992-1993 President. He also served on the Nebraska Beef Check-Off Board for eight years and traveled to Central and South America with the US Meat Export Federation promoting beef. In 1997, the family picked up their roots and cattle, and all moved west to the Wyoming border southwest of Harrison. They hosted the Nebraska Junior Angus Show at Fort Robinson, and a few Nebraska Angus Tours. They have exhibited at Husker Harvest Days, the Nebraska State Fair, Wyoming State Fair, Central States Fair, the NILE, Denver Stock Show, Western Junior Stock Show and the Black Hills Stock Show. In 2008, Gray's Angus bred and raised steers that won the Champion National Certified Angus Beef Angus Source Carcass Challenge. They have also exported registered Angus breeding stock to Russia and Turkey.

Today, living on the ranch doing daily management along with Rod and Laura are their sons Heath and Garret. The ranch has pivots for raising alfalfa and corn silage for winter feed. At an altitude of 4600 to 5000 feet, the growing season is about 90 days. Their son Colt and wife Riyatta and their daughter Keirra are close by on Wyoming property and regularly help out. Son Levi, wife Sarah and their kids Cooper and Kendall, take in Gray's Angus pairs for the summer on their ground in the White River country. Their daughter Naomi and her husband Jeff Pelster and their family, Chisum, Ruger, Linnea, Canton and Kimberlynn ranch north of Harrison on the Coffee War Bonnet Ranch. They have Gray's Angus bloodlines in their cow herd and have a yearling operation. Grandpa Rod has started the seventh generation showing Angus breeding stock where Chisum had a Champion Angus Bull at the Western Junior Livestock Show in Rapid City this fall. They all take the Angus cattle business seriously and help out tremendously with the spring bull sale, branding, and ranch work.



This time of year, the Grays are sorting through the 400+ bull calves, picking out the top one-third to offer for sale. Careful selection for a "Complete Package" including dam production, performance, profitable EPD's and soundness are being closely monitored. Later born calves are held over for two-year old buyers. The bulls are developed at the ranch on a sensible, low concentrate diet with ample room to exercise. Heifer calves are also wintered at the ranch,

synchronized, and AI'd before trailing to grass for the summer. Calving usually starts the first of February with AI and ET calves. All the pairs leave the main ranch for the growing season. There are several environmental challenges for the herd from year to year. At White River and Deep Creek, south of Crawford, the terrain has very steep ravines and is covered with pine trees. Up at Provo, South Dakota, the pairs face sparse water, is treeless, and is a drought susceptible gumbo. For Sioux county the hard grass is great, but is also drought susceptible in the high plains, shortgrass prairie.

Rod has kept a closed cow herd through the years, keeping the very best genetics going. With hardy Angus bloodlines tracing back to the original Gray's cow herd, these females have been tried and proven to perform in various range conditions and terrains. The cows go to work, take care of themselves and their calves, and rebreed to do it all over again the next year. The steers are fed in a feedlot and consistently finish with an ADG over 4.5lbs/day, carcasses grade 95% choice and higher, and 57% CAB and Prime. Grays are all about providing good quality beef for consumers, and profitability for their customers. They will be hosting their 27th "2nd Century" Performance Bull Sale at the Ranch the third Saturday in March. All of the family has been a big part of the entire success for the operation; from our ancestors and extended family to the kids and grandkids who are actively involved now. Everyone has been very thankful to God for His blessings and favor.

2021 ANNUAL MEETING RECAP

ANNUAL MEETING

The 2021 Nebraska Angus Association Meeting and Banquet was held in Kearney, Nebraska at the Holiday Inn/Younes Convention Center on December 4th, 2021. The afternoon events included one educational speaker and the annual meeting. The speaker for the afternoon was Brianna Buseman who grew up in Canistota, South Dakota. Brianna currently works as the Youth Meat Animal Extension Assistant Professor at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. In this position, she develops youth programming to teach students about meat production and seeks to introduce them to potential careers in the industry. Additionally, she teaches the meat evaluation, grading and judging class at UNL and coaches the meat judging team. She discussed qualities of meat, proper processes to get the best cut, and informed producers of how stress affects the final product of meat. Brianna invited anyone to contact her if they would like her to provide a presentation for youth in their area. Following her presentation, the annual meeting proceeded with 23 members in presence.

After the meeting a short social was enjoyed with speaker Dr. George Perry. Dr Perry, who was raised in south-central Texas on a small cattle operation received his bachelor's degree in animal science from Texas A&M University. He obtained a master's degree and a doctoral degree in reproductive physiology from the University of Missouri, with a large portion of his doctoral research conducted at the USDA research station in Miles City, Montana. Dr. Perry was a faculty member and Beef Reproduction extension specialist in the animal Science department at South Dakota State University for 17 years. He now serves as an Associate Professor with Texas AgriLife at the Overton Research station. His research efforts are in the area of factors that influence reproductive efficiency, pregnancy success, and embryo mortality. Some of his current research has focused on understanding why variations occur between herds, the impact of vaccination of reproductive success, and factors impacting sperm longevity. Dr. Perry provided a phenomenal presentation on timelines for breeding with AI and how vaccines affect conception rates.

Rounding out the evening was the annual banquet. A delicious steak dinner

was served for the evening with several Nebraska Angus awards and speeches, including the crowning of the 2022 Nebraska Angus Royalty winner: Rachel Smith, recognition of the 2021 Producer of the Year: Gray's Angus Ranch, and the acknowledgement of the heifer raffle scholarship winners: 1st place- Rachel Smith, 2nd place- Kacey Dethlefs, and 3rd place- Kyra Meyer. Also speaking during the event was Tavin Uden the Nebraska Junior Angus Association President, outgoing Nebraska Angus

Queen TaraLee Hudson, Heather Smith the Nebraska Angus Auxiliary President, and Rachel Smith the new 2022 Nebraska Angus Queen and a 2021 finalist for Miss American Angus. A directory page auction, junior semen auction, and Nebraska Angus Auxiliary silent auction also concluded. We want to thank everyone who participated in the 2021 Annual Meeting and Banquet and we look forward to next year's event!

LEWIS "LEW" LAFLIN

Lewis "Lew" Laflin, 88, of Crab Orchard, passed away at the Good Samaritan Center in Beatrice on October 17, 2021. He was born to Lewis and Maree (Shiek) Laflin on January 3, 1933 at Crab Orchard. Angus Breeders Discuss Balance as a Tool for Longevity

How can breeders balance operational goals with long term goals in mind?

Geography creates different challenges for operations across the country. Even with those obstacles, breeders achieve success year after year. During the 2021 National Angus Convention and Trade Show Genetics Symposium sponsored by NEOGEN®, Kelli Retallick-Riley, president of Angus Genetics Inc., (AGI) moderated a panel of Angus breeders that represented diversity but were consistent on maintaining the longevity of their operation. Gordon Stucky of Stucky Ranch, Adam Sawyer of A&B Angus and Scott Pohlman of Pohlman Cattle Company shared perspectives, resources and ideas on how they create a plan and stick to it.

As panelists shared their own breeding objectives, all mentioned they focus on meeting the needs of their customers. Sawyer shared how ninety percent of their bull buyers derive their income from the cattle business, so they look at many traits to suit multiple needs.

Sawyer said, "The female is very important to us, but we also have a set of criteria for carcass traits that we don't go below to stay on track with industry standards."

Hailing from the panhandle of Texas, Pohlman shared his perspective of raising cattle on drought-prone land with minimal grass. He mentioned how important it is to not get caught up with the "latest and greatest top-selling herd sire." He knows some of his customers won't be able to capture the full genetic potential of that sire in the environment they live in. Pohlman believes in focusing on the foundational traits long term.

Aside from balanced breeding objectives and balanced traits, some may argue about the definition of balance. Sawyer defines balance as an all-encompassing term, where cattleman can find everything they need to have breeding cattle that will work in a particular environment. Stucky believes a balanced cow herd has no holes.

Panelist also highlighted the importance of data collection,

especially since the American Angus Association® recently surpassed the one million genotype mark. Coupling genomics and EPDs has allowed Sawyer and his operation to have more confidence in the data. For Stucky, submitting data through Angus Herd Improvement Records (AHIR) and MaternalPlus allows them to evaluate their whole herd every year. The data assists them in sorting their herd to help them determine the direction they want to go.

"The future of data collection will surely be better. We just have to be

patient," Stucky said.

Finding balance will continue to improve as Retallick-Riley shared the research being developed at AGI. However, she reminded the membership that the work is never done. There is always more to learn.

Producers and industry professionals discuss the power of genetic data

Maximizing the use of genetic data will pay dividends.

The Angus University: Genetics workshop sponsored by Zoetis at the 2021 National Angus Convention and Trade Show served as an educational session to inform breeders about the value of collecting genetic data and ways to use it in decision making. The panel included moderator, Kelli Retallick-Riley, president of Angus Genetics Inc. (AGI), and four panelists – Justin Sexten, vice president of strategy and product development for Performance Livestock Analytics; Jim Moore of Moore Cattle Company, a commercial Angus operation; James Henderson of Bradley 3 Ranch, an Angus seedstock

operation; Troy Marshall, director of commercial industry relations for the American Angus Association.

Understanding and valuing genetic data can present as a daunting task to seedstock and commercial producers alike. Retallick-Riley asked panelists to describe how they use genetic data to navigate breeding decisions and market cattle to the next industry segment.

“Being able to have some prediction of what those cattle are really worth and being able to get that kind of value out of them and they perform accordingly makes it better for all of us,” Henderson said. “We can sit down with an individual customer and say, ‘Here’s where you are today, here’s where you want to be and here’s what it’s going to take to do that.’”

Sometimes the primary struggle with data stems from the collection

process. Sexten emphasized how modern technology provides breeders with the tools to efficiently collect data, document it and convey the information to each sector of the supply chain.

“From a technology perspective, we think about it as how do I take the notes you take on a cow that’s locked up in text messages, snapshots on your phone and notes on a piece of paper that’s thrown up on the dash and convey that up and down the supply chain in a way that the association can make predictions from it,” Sexten said. “I think technology provides us the ability to convey information across all of these segments. So that’s how we think about it is how can we convey information, not just gather more and more data.”

Marshall encouraged the use of programs like AngusLinkSM which

provides commercial producers the opportunity to maximize data collection efforts and more importantly, maximize profits.

“Those buyers up and down the chain need information, they need market flexibility, market access, and they’re looking to mitigate their risk and these programs give them that,” Marshall said. As a result, AngusLink has helped to capture more premiums. “This last year, the people enrolled in the AngusLink program had an average return of about \$84 over the market. Over the last three years, we’ve returned almost \$12.5 million in premiums to commercial producers. I think this information flow is just going to continue to grow.”

In addition to the AngusLink program, the GeneMax Advantage test allows commercial cattlemen to receive genetic information on unregistered females to make strategic decisions when selecting replacements.

“I think one of the underutilized things about [GeneMax Advantage] is if you know what you’re replacing, you also know what bulls to select, so you get a double advantage,” Moore said. “I think that GeneMax Advantage just gives you the opportunity to differentiate yourself in the marketplace and objectively describe the cattle so you can capture the value they deserve.”

The role genetic data plays in any operation will likely continuously

increase over time. Henderson said if you haven’t already, the time to start using genetic data to enhance your decision making is now.

“I think if you’re not looking at genetic information today in your herd, whether you’re a commercial or a seedstock operation, you’re probably falling behind very quickly,” Henderson said. “It’s time to get into the education process and figure out where you are from a genetic standpoint.”
