Inflation, drought, low financial compensation, and decreasing ranching interest are some of the biggest challenges our current producers are dealing with. With all those challenges I am sure many of you a time or two have questioned yourself and why you continue to be in the cattle business. Glynn Tonsor, a professor of agricultural economics at Kansas State University discussed recently at the Kansas Beef Summit that in 2014, it cost \$879 to run a cow, compared to \$852 in 2021. In 2022, it will be up by more than \$100 per cow to \$963. In 2023, the cost to run a cow will hit \$1,000. (Amy Hadachek, Dec 8 2022, Midwest Messenger).

When asked "What bloodlines do you use in your herd and how do you market your breeding program?" Jeff answered, "We focus on our customers, look for solid phenotype cattle that can go out and work. Our production sale is coming up January 27th 2023. We will offer 18-mo-old and yearling bulls sired by Growth Fund, Accomplishment, Rawhide and Ruggles Charisma to name a few. We will sell

125 bulls and offer free wintering and free nationwide delivery." He also mentioned "You will get out of it as much as you're willing to put in. This business will pull you in several different directions but if you have a goal keep striving for it."

Jeff commented about some of the future goals the Association has for itself including, trying to figure out more ways to involve the commercial Angus producers and to offer programs to help commercial producers. Jeff stated "remember the board and association are here for the membership. Our goal is to bring awareness to the commercial and registered sectors of the Angus breed here in Nebraska."

As Jeff moves into the Past President role, he wants members to know that the most rewarding part about being a member of the Association board and an officer is, "Meeting new people along the way and getting to know some of the premier breeders in our association. As producers we have the same lifestyles and interests in cattle, but different operations, so there are a lot of opportunities to see different ideas."

NEBRASKA PRODUCER OF THE YEAR

CONNEALY ANGUS The roots of Connealy Angus started with Donnie Vinton Connealy's ancestors in the late 1880s who homesteaded south of Whitman, Nebraska.

Connealy Angus was founded in 1961 by Marty and Donnie Connealy with the purchase of 20 registered Angus heifers.

It was a bold move to bring those black cows into Hereford Country, but it was the start of an exciting new venture. Marty and Donnie raised seven children on the ranch, and set the stage for the importance of family in their business.



Marty and Donnie jumped into the Angus business with both feet. Marty learned how to AI and supplemented their income by AI-ing milk cows in the local area. That skill transferred to the Angus herd, and the first bull sale in 1969 was held in the original sale barn that is still in use today.

At age 14, Jerry went to AI school to help his dad, and was always keenly interested in the genetics of the herd. As it looked like Marty and Donnie's other six kids were going to choose different career paths, Jerry and Sharon came back to the ranch after college in 1981.

At that time, the herd consisted of 120 cows. It was the 1980s. Cattle prices were low, and interest rates were soaring. The Connealys were able to hang on and eventually expand, and have now grown the herd to over 3000 registered cows.

Calving (and therefore breeding) now takes place four times a year. Native hay is harvested each summer. As with most agricultural operations, it seems like there is always plenty to do.

A few over 1000 bulls are marketed each year through a fall sale, a spring sale, as well as some private treaty offerings. Other enterprises

under the ranch umbrella include Connealy Marketing, which assists in the buying and selling of feeder cattle, and Connealy Angus Meat Market, which provides premium beef to restaurants and offers online sales. Jerry and Sharon were blessed to have raised four kids on the ranch; Jed, Ben, Hannah and Gabriel, and today they are sharing their passion with their nine grandchildren.

Jed is essential to the Commercial Cattle Services portion of Connealy Angus, the AI program, bull delivery – any and all kinds of assorted ranch work. He is engaged to Jais, a practicing veterinarian, and has three children, Cian, Colin, and Aislynn.

Ben lives in San Diego and is living a long-time dream as a civilian contractor for Navy Medicine. He's successful, he's happy, and he loves the San Diego area and weather.

Hannah and her three kids, Charlotte, Rudy and Henriette, are often visiting her parents as she is the point person for Connealy Angus Meat Market, helps Sharon with data entry, and also helps around the ranch.

Gabriel is integral in the genetic selection process for the herd, as well as calving, breeding, ultrasound preg-checking, freeze branding, bull

delivery – and various day to day tasks. His wife Becca, a practicing registered nurse, also helps with many ranch and office duties. They and their three boys, Finnegan, Martin, and Mickey, live in the house at the sale site.



In addition to all the outside labor that Jerry is involved in daily, he and Sharon have worked together as a team for years. Sharon's emphasis has always been on accounting, record keeping and marketing for the ranch.

In November, Jerry completed 8 years of service to the American Angus Association's Board of Directors, serving as the Chairman of the Board this last year.

During that service he worked to keep the Angus breed on the cutting edge of the beef industry. He found that the other board members were a wonderful mixture of talent and

intelligence, and brought fascinating perspectives to the table based on the region of their operation, herd size, and customer base. Those years also gave him a profound appreciation for all that is accomplished at the Association by its superior staff.

The Connealys are so grateful for the unprecedented opportunities the Angus breed has brought to their family, and are continually thankful for their many blessings.

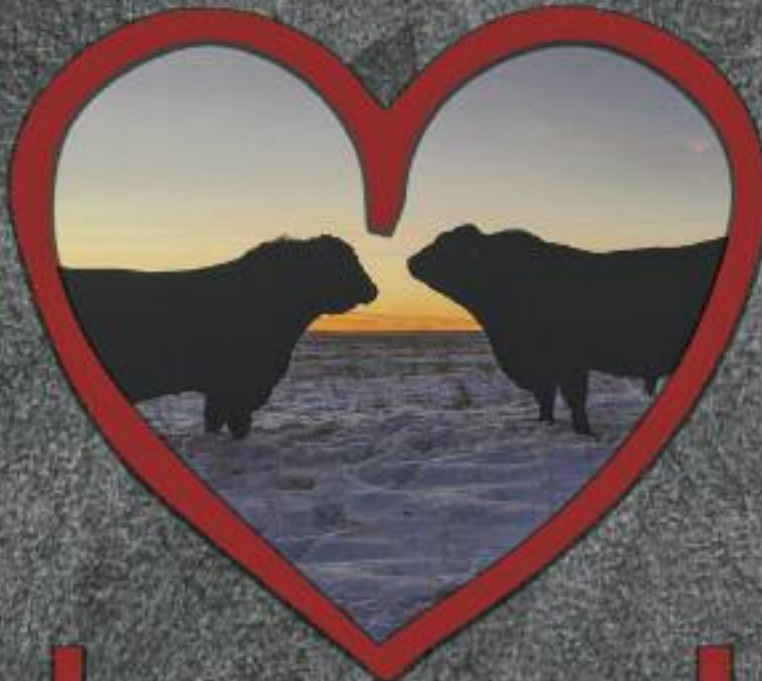

Genetics Drive Conversation for Profitability of Commercial Cattlemen

Capturing Value panelists discuss opportunities to differentiate, niche down and stand out.

Cost of gain increases, black-hided cattle market saturation and tight supplies due to weather are all challenging the commercial cattlemen today. How do they stay profitable amidst the market? During the 2022 Angus Convention in Salt Lake City, Utah November 5, the AngusLinkSM team hosted the Capturing Value session. The session aimed to help commercial producers learn how to capture more value for their calves so they can continue to face challenges but remain profitable.

Troy Marshall, director of commercial industry relations for the American Angus Association®, moderated a panel including Terrill Ostrum, livestock broker; Jordan Willis, cow-calf producer; Joe Goggins, Angus breeder and auctioneer; and Jed Connealy, Angus breeder and cattle marketer. Each panelist actively engages with cow-calf producers, but also have a hand in other sectors of the industry.

Regardless of their positions, panelists talked optimistically about the future, especially when discussing ways to earn a premium or a few more dollars for their calves. There are plenty of programs and opportunities, said Ostrum.

Connealy agreed. "I think there is a pile of opportunity and the gap between good cattle and bad cattle gets wider all the time," he said.

For those focused on raising good cattle, panelists shared ways those producers could earn more money and stay profitable. For many of them, genetics were key. Goggins said the number one thing to consider is buying good bulls with genetic value.

"Those invested in the feeding industry, we know the people who buy good bulls. We know the people who have watched their Ps and Qs as far as not only carcass but performance and fertility and everything," said Goggins.

Connealy takes those superior genetics and quantifies them through AngusLink's Genetic Merit Scorecard. Understanding exactly what kind of bulls those producers bought and how those cattle are geared, it's easy to make a connection and know where cattle would fit best, said Connealy.

"We work pretty closely with customers, so I don't know who else would be better versed to do that [match cattle to buyers] rather than the genetic guy in the equation," said Connealy.

Willis said commercial producers have opportunities to capture more value if they start thinking about marketing. He stressed that marketing is what sets themselves apart on sale day.

"I think as cow-calf producers, we must put our marketing caps on," said Willis. "We work our tails off every day doing the daily jobs, but when it comes to marketing, I think we fall short."

Cow-calf producers also need to find the right seedstock producer and build a relationship with them. Seedstock providers need to know what works and what we need in our operation said Willis. Connealy adds that producers should get behind a program that

already aligns with their goals to help build consistency in their operation. Ostrum said he purchases program cattle because of their consistency.

"The most predictable cattle I buy on an annual basis are cattle who have tied to a program year after year after year and are taking some advice and some counsel from the seedstock producer," said Ostrum.

Flipping the script, seedstock producers can communicate with their customers to build relationships and help them be successful. One step can be helping their customers interpret the important data needed for bull buyers to make better decisions based on their environment and situation, said Ostrum. For Goggins, he said people buy people they like, know and trust.

"We all work in the agricultural business, but we are also in the people business," said Goggins.

Through genetics and marketing programs, the panel shared several tactics and thought processes commercial cattlemen can use to grow their operation. At the end of the day, getting better might just mean doing something new.

"Let's get out of that paradigm and dare to do something no matter what part of the world you're in," said Ostrum. "Look at those different opportunities and dare to do something different."
