

Dear Nebraska Angus Friends,

few years ago, I wrote a column about AngusLink. It all started in the summer of 2018, and at that time there were a lot of questions surrounding its inception.

With 20/20 hindsight, yes there were some different choices that could have been made. However, with that same hindsight, it was the fastest and most efficient way for the Association to launch a program that would reward commercial producers for superior genetics and differentiate their calves' value to potential buyers.

I'm grateful that we jumped in when we did, and would like to note that AngusLink has been expanded to include USDA Process Verified Programs (PVP), as well. These allimportant additions bring the opportunity for even more value for our producers' calves as they are rewarded for particular care and handling practices.

With AngusLink, important data can be delivered to feeders so that they can also use the Angus Association's science to make better decisions for the cattle they purchase – whether they are selling strictly by performance, on the grid, or a combination of the two.

As we head into the fourth year of AngusLink, let's revisit a brief overview of the Genetic Merit Scores.

The graphic below gives a general picture of the scoring of the AngusLink enrolled cattle. The AngusLink scores' foundation is based on the American Angus Association \$Value indexes: \$B (beef score), \$F (feedlot performance score) and \$G (grid score). The \$Values are built from current EPDs, which are built from actual carcass data.

Each of the three scores are derived from the producer's current bull battery, their past bull battery and the breed composition of the producer's cow herd. The more information provided the more accurate the genetic prediction of the score.

The bull battery is determined at enrollment time, and the Association has a great staff of individuals to assist folks with the enrollment process.





Beef Score – Predicts Genetic potential for feedlot performance and carcass value by looking at EPDs such as carcass weight, marbling, and feed efficiency.

Feedlot Performance Score – Signifies the enrollment group's potential for postweaning performance in the feedlot and takes into account average daily gain and dray matter intake EPDs.

Grid Score – Predicts the enrollment group's performance potential for carcass grid merit, referencing marbling, fat and ribeye area EPDs.

The Certified Angus Beef[®] brand Targeting the Brand[™] logo appearson the scorecard when enrollment groups meet the phenotypic and genetic specifications listed below:

Phenotype

Each animal in the marketing group must be predominantly solid black and meet the live-animal specification for Angus branded programs. For more information see Carcass Specifications for Approved Programs.

Genetic

Enrollment groups earn a grid score of 125 or higher.

In addition to Genetic Merit scores, options for USDA PVP participation include:

Age & Source

Non-Hormone Treated Cattle (NHTC)


Any of these programs could potentially add value to folks' calf crops if they choose to participate. The information found at angus.org/AngusLink is exceptional and easy to understand.

AngusLink and its associated PVP programs have proven their value time and again in the prices received for these calves. The small fee for participation seems to be a great value for many.

2022 Auxiliary Scholarships Available for Junior Angus Members

The American Angus Auxiliary scholarships are presented annually. The total amount awarded will vary. Ten (10) scholarships will be awarded. The exact amount of the first, second, third, fourth and fifth place awards given to both boy and girl qualified applicants will be determined by May 1, 2022. Scholarships may be defined as financial grants for which no equivalent work is required.

Each state is entitled to submit one girl and one boy application for the national scholarships. The two applications must be submitted by the state or regional scholarship chairperson to the American Angus Auxiliary Scholarship Chairperson. All scholarship applicants are encouraged to attend the National Junior Angus Show in early July.

The scholarship application is the basis from which the candidates are chosen to compete for Miss American Angus. Each girl submitting a scholarship application will be required to complete a form declaring her intent to compete/not compete for Miss American Angus if given the opportunity. The five highest placing girls choosing to compete for Miss American Angus will be announced at the National Junior Show. These girls will be required to attend the Miss American Angus contest held in November at the Angus Convention. The intent form and additional information on the role and requirements of Miss American Angus will be mailed to each girl applicant AFTER her scholarship application is received. (Please note: choosing not to compete for Miss American Angus does not affect scholarship eligibility.)

Early Entries & Early Entry Fees due May 20, 2022

Bedding will be provided in the barn. Tie outs will be available; you will need to provide your own bedding for tie outs. Straw is allowed in tie outs. The Nebraska Junior Angus Show is a "No Fit" show defined as exhibitors may NOT use glue, adhesive, foam, coloring or paint products. Oils and "Kleen Sheen" type products are allowed. No stomach pumping or artificial fillers allowed.

A.ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS AND ENTRIES

- 1. Exhibitors must be members of the NeJAA and must be between the ages of 8-21 as of January 1 of the current year. Junior membership shall be issued only to an individual and shall expire upon attainment of age 21. Participation is acceptable through the calendar year of the individual's 21st birthday.
- 2. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor.
- 3. Eligibility of entries will be determined by age and the National Junior Angus Association show classification.
- 4. Exhibitors in the bred-and-owned categories must be the breeder and first and continuous owner of the animal entered.
- 5. Exhibitors may show up to six entries in the owned heifer category and up to four entries in the steer category. They may also show as many bred-and-owned bulls, bred-and-owned heifers, and cow-calf pairs as they wish.
- 6. Must present original certificate or electronic registration at check-in. All tattoos must be legible.
- 7. The show will be blow and go.
- 8. The ownership deadline for the State Angus Show shall coincide with the National Junior Angus Show, May 15th, 2022.

B. CLASSES

- 1. The classes will be the same as recommended by the National Junior Angus Association. There will be classes for bred-and-owned heifers, bred-and owned bulls, owned heifers, phenotype/genotype heifers, registered steers, cow/calf pairs, and predominantly black hided crossbred steers and heifers. There must be at least 5 or more head to have a separate bred and owned division.
- 2. There will be an additional class for best pair of heifers. Both heifers must be shown by the same exhibitor on show day to qualify as a pair.
- 3. There will be a Supreme Champion selected from the Champion owned heifer, bred-and-owned heifer, cow-calf pair, and bull.

C. SHOWMANSHIP

1.Showmanship classes will be divided according to age as of January 1 of the current year following the National Junior Angus Association's age divisions for contests. The Junior Division: 13 and under, Intermediate Division: 14-17, and Senior Division: 18-21. To be eligible for showmanship contests, partic ipants must be exhibiting an animal at the show.

Unless otherwise stated, National Junior Angus Show rules apply.

PARTICIPATING IN NATIONAL SHOWMANSHIP CLASS:

Two contestants will be selected to represent Nebraska at the National Junior Angus Show from a specified NJAS showmanship class at the State Junior Show. To represent Nebraska at the National Showmanship contest, the exhibitor must be a Junior or Life Member of the Nebraska and American Angus Association, an active member of the Nebraska Junior Angus Association. All fees must be paid before entering the contest. Contestants by entering agree to abide by the NeJAA and NJAA rules. Contestant's birth date must be from Jan 1, 2001 through Dec 31, 2007.

•Active Member being defined as having participated in state, regional, or national Angus shows/activities in one of the past two years, current year excluded.
