President Speaks

Opportunities for Angus Staying in the Driver's Seat

hat exciting times we are in! Cattle markets are at all time highs, and the experts say it's going to get even better.

At the popular CattleFax Outlook Seminar, held as part of the 2024 Cattle Industry Convention and NCBA Trade Show in Orlando, Florida, in late January, market analysts shared that the smallest beef cow inventory in the last 50 years, coupled with historically strong demand, led to the highest average fed cattle and calf prices in 2023. As reduced cattle numbers and beef production continue over the next three years, leverage and profitability will continue to favor cattle producers.

Specifically, Mike Murphy, CattleFax chief operating officer, forecasted the average 2024 fed steer price at \$184/cwt., up \$9/cwt. from 2023. All cattle classes are expected to trade higher, and prices are expected to continue to trend upward. According to CattleFax, the 800-lb. steer price is expected to average \$240/cwt., and the 550-lb. steer price is expected to average \$290/cwt. Utility cows are expected to average \$115/cwt., with bred cows at an average of \$2,600/head.

Higher cattle prices and reduced feeding costs will continue to improve margins for cow-calf producers for the next several years, a much-needed improvement to drive expansion of the U.S. cowherd as weather patterns allow, according to CattleFax.

In preparing for those forecasts to come to fruition, Angus breeders and users of Angus genetics have great opportunities to realize the maximum



profit from our current and future calf crops. We are fortunate that the great state of Nebraska has some of the very best genetics available in our breed – and these cattle are backed by some of the best cattle people in America.

As we move toward spring and bull buying season and breeding season, I want to remind breeders of the importance of investing in and upgrading our genetics. Like buying a good truck or improved piece of farm equipment, quality genetics of bulls and females are an investment that typically pays dividends for years to come. And, I'll point out that the cull market is pretty strong right now, so you can also capture value for the cattle that you are replacing.

Best of all, Angus genetics are diverse with a large population and many breeders who offer an array of genetic choices within the breed. If your focus is on maternal or carcass or high growth or calving ease for heifers or a combination of all, you can find the traits that your wants and needs. It's all available in the Angus breed. So, let's keep Angus strong and in the driver's seat as we move toward this upward trend in the market and continue to produce the best Angus beef for consumers.



2024 Nebraska Jr. Angus Show

June 1-2, 2024 Fairgrounds – Broken Bow, Nebraska

May begin arriving any time on Friday, May 31, 2024 Cattle Check-in: Saturday from 9-noon (cattle must be on the grounds and checked in by noon) National Team Contests Saturday afternoon (fitting, sales, quiz bowl) Junior Meeting Saturday Afternoon Family Picnic on Saturday at 7:00 p.m. Show Begins Sunday, June 2, 2023 at 9:00 a.m.

Early Entries & Early Entry Fees due May 15, 2024

Bedding will be provided in the barn. Tie outs will be available; you will need to provide your own bedding for tie outs. Straw is allowed in tie outs. The Nebraska Junior Angus Show is a "No Fit" show defined as exhibitors may NOT use glue, adhesive, foam, coloring or paint products. Oils and "Kleen Sheen" type products are allowed. No stomach pumping or artificial fillers allowed.

A.ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS AND ENTRIES

- 1. Exhibitors must be members of the NeJAA and must be between the ages of 8-21 as of January 1 of the current year. Junior membership shall be issued only to an individual and shall expire upon attainment of age 21. Participation is acceptable through the calendar year of the individual's 21st birthday.
- 2. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor.
- 3. Eligibility of entries will be determined by age and the National Junior Angus Association show classification.
- 4. Exhibitors in the bred-and-owned categories must be the breeder and first and continuous owner of the animal entered.
- 5. Exhibitors may show up to six entries in the owned heifer category and up to four entries in the steer category. They may also show as many bred-and-owned bulls, bred-and-owned heifers, and cow-calf pairs as they wish.
- 6. Must present original certificate or electronic registration at check-in. All tattoos must be legible.
- 7. The show will be blow and go.
- 8. The ownership deadline for the State Angus Show shall coincide with the National Junior Angus Show, May 15th, 2024.

B. CLASSES

- 1. The classes will be the same as recommended by the National Junior Angus Association. There will be classes for bred-and-owned heifers, bred-and owned bulls, owned heifers, phenotype/genotype heifers, registered steers, cow/calf pairs, and predominantly black hided crossbred steers and heifers. There must be at least 5 or more head to have a separate bred and owned division.
- 2. There will be an additional class for best pair of heifers. Both heifers must be shown by the same exhibitor on show day to qualify as a pair.
- 3. There will be a Supreme Champion selected from the Champion owned heifer, bred-and-owned heifer, cow-calf pair, and bull.

C. SHOWMANSHIP

1.Showmanship classes will be divided according to age as of January 1 of the current year following the National Junior Angus Association's age divisions for contests. The Junior Division: 13 and under, Intermediate Division: 14-17, and Senior Division: 18-21. To be eligible for showmanship contests, partic ipants must be exhibiting an animal at the show.

Unless otherwise stated, National Junior Angus Show rules apply.

PARTICIPATING IN NATIONAL SHOWMANSHIP CLASS:

Two contestants will be selected to represent Nebraska at the National Junior Angus Show from a specified NJAS showmanship class at the State Junior Show. To represent Nebraska at the National Showmanship contest, the exhibitor must be a Junior or Life Member of the Nebraska and American Angus Association, an active member of the Nebraska Junior Angus Association. All fees must be paid before entering the contest. Contestants by entering agree to abide by the NeJAA and NJAA rules.

•Active Member being defined as having participated in state, regional, or national Angus shows/activities in one of the past two years, current year excluded.

SON Ferguson Angus uses IGUS data-backed decisions **Building Better Beet**



Lynn and Lori Ferguson rely on data as they make management decisions for their herd.

Nestled on the plains of north central Kansas, roughly halfway between Denver and Kansas City, Ferguson Angus has stood proudly since 1946.

The family-run operation, owned and run by Lynn and Lori Ferguson as well as their nephew and his wife, Brice and Vicki Korobka, breeds registered Angus cattle and raises corn, wheat, soybeans, alfalfa, grain sorghum and forage sorghum.

"Ferguson Angus is a family operated farm and ranch who love to grow great crops and the best black Angus that genetics, technology and the environment allows," said Lynn Ferguson.

While the operation was started by Lynn Ferguson's parents, Ferguson bought his

first registered Angus cattle in 1972 and hasn't looked back

In the early 1980s, he started an AI program, which he continues to run today.

Ferguson is a selfdescribed numbers guy, with data playing a key role in his operation.

"I have been very excited about the Angus GS data that DNA generates and the value and accuracy it adds to the performance EPDs," he said.

Angus GS is a genomic selection tool from Neogen, built specifically for Angus cattle in partnership with the American Angus Association

Ferguson's selection process isn't something he takes lightly, and the Angus GS data is just one small part of it.

The first two selections of the sale bulls are done during weaning. Ferguson, along with his wife and nephew, assess each and every bull both visually and on the scale

If any of them determine the bull doesn't meet their rigorous standard, it's culled

After weaning, they end up with an average of about 140 bulls out of 250 possible prospects. After a few weeks, the family walks the pens and makes a second cut. strictly using visual appraisal. Ferguson looks for general eye appeal, thickness, length, feet and leg structure, and disposition among other traits.

During the weaning process, DNA is collected

on every bull. Those that remain after the first two cuts have their DNA sent to AGI for genomic evaluation.

Once that information is returned, the family goes through the bulls a third time before finally registering those that make the cut. Once registered, each

bull's EPD gets pulled up

online for evaluation. Those not meeting Ferguson's EPD criteria are then culled as are those who don't measure up at yearling weigh time.

"The fact is, our selection process goes up to and through the penning process the morning of the sale," he said, referencing his annual bull sale.

Select Sires has previously purchased two bulls, Ferguson Breakout and

Ferguson Trailblazer. Semen from both bulls are sold both domestically as well as in international markets.

Bulls at Ferguson Angus are developed with a high

roughage ration, promoting longevity and soundness. They are never fed creep feed. They're bred for carcass merit and feedlot excellence, early growth and calving ease.

Ferguson Angus cows and heifers are synced up using the 7 and 7 protocol, and every female is artificially inseminated.

Older cows are calved at a property along the Solomon River with plenty of evergreen trees, sandhills covered with tall grass, sunflowers and 5- to 7-foot tall kochia providing excellent protection from the elements.

"That combined with the excellent mothering ability of a good Angus cow makes for a successful calving season," Ferguson said.

The 34th annual Ferguson Angus bull sale will be held Tuesday, March 26, 2024.

Ferguson Angus sells approximately 100 bulls each year. Bulls selling at the annual sale in March

The Nebraska Angus Association annually offers scholarships to Angus youth. This year we are proud to announce that the Nebraska Angus Auxiliary will be partnering with this scholarship again and we will be offering \$1,250 in scholarship money. The winners will be announced at the Nebraska Junior Angus State Show. Individuals who have been awarded this scholarship in past years may reapply but no more than \$1,000 will be awarded to any one individual.

Applicant must be a Nebraska resident, current member of the Nebraska Junior Angus Association and current junior member of the American Angus Association or, if over 21, a former member of both organizations. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or undergraduate who will be enrolling in a 2 or 4 year post high school educational program in the coming year. Applicant's parents must be members of the Nebraska Angus Association.

Angus Foundation scholarship applications open now

Youth can apply for Angus Foundation scholarships until May 1.

Scholarship applications are now available for college students involved with the Angus breed. The Angus Foundation awarded more than \$358,000 in scholarships in 2023 alone. Certified Angus Beef®/National Junior Angus Association Scholarship

Since 1990, the NJAA has teamed up with Certified Angus Beef® (CAB) to help Angus youth pursue their higher education goals. The selected applicant will receive a \$1,500 scholarship. A separate application from the Angus Foundation scholarship application is required for the CAB/NJAA scholarship.

Commercial Cattlemen Scholarship

The Angus Foundation will award four \$1,500 scholarships to undergraduate students who use Angus genetics in a commercial cattle operation's breeding program or whose parents use Angus genetics. Emphasis will be placed on applicants' knowledge of the cattle industry and perspective of the Angus breed. The applicant or their parent/guardian must have transferred or been transferred an Angus registration paper in the last 36 months (on or after May 1, 2021) and must be considered commercial and not seedstock in their operation. The scholarship applies to any field of study.

2024 Auxiliary Scholarships Available for Junior Angus **Members**

The American Angus Auxiliary scholarships are presented annually. The total amount awarded will vary. Ten (10) scholarships will be awarded. The exact amount of the first, second, third, fourth and fifth place awards given to both male and female qualified applicants will be determined by May 1, 2024. Scholarships may be defined as financial grants for which no equivalent work is required.

Each state is entitled to submit one girl and one boy application for the national scholarships. The two applications must be submitted by the state or regional scholarship chairperson to the American Angus Auxiliary Scholarship Chairperson. If your state does not have an Auxiliary State/Regional Scholarship Chair, a designated representative from the State/Regional Angus Association, or the State Junior Angus Advisors should submit the completed application. Please contact the American Angus Auxiliary Scholarship Chair with questions.

All scholarship applicants are encouraged to attend the National Junior Angus Show in early July.

The scholarship application is the basis from which the candidates are chosen to compete for Miss American Angus. Each young lady submitting a scholarship application will be required to complete a form declaring her intent to compete/not compete for Miss American Angus if given the opportunity. The five highest placing ladies choosing to compete for Miss American Angus will be announced at the National Junior Show. These ladies will be required to attend the Miss American Angus contest held in November at the Angus Convention. The intent form and additional information on the role and requirements of Miss American Angus will be mailed to each female applicant AFTER her scholarship application is received. (Please note: choosing not to compete for Miss

American Angus does not affect scholarship eligibility.)
