NEBRASKA PRODUCER OF THE YEAR

Ostrand Angus Ranch, owned and operated by Kory & Danielle Ostrand, is located south of Ansley in the rolling hills of Custer County. The ranch has been in the Ostrand family since 1884, when Kory's Great-Great-Grandparents, August and Caroline Ostrand, came from Sweden and registered their homestead southwest of Mason City.



Kory is the 5th generation raising cattle and farming on the Ostrand Ranch, but is the 1st generation with registered Angus. Kory purchased his first registered Angus heifer from Boyles Angus when he was nine years old. He grew his herd by purchasing additional females from the money he received from his 4-H projects. In 2001, Kory held his first bull sale at Huss Livestock Market in Kearney, when he was still in high school. He continued to manage and grow his cow herd while attending college. Following his college graduation, he moved back to the ranch to continue farming and ranching.

The Ostrand Angus herd grew in late 2012 when they had the opportunity to purchase the mature cow herd from Slagle Angus of Sargent. This expanded their registered herd from 120 to 420 head. For the next seven years, they worked side by side with Slagle Angus hosting joint production sales at the Slagle Ranch. Through this time, they learned so much; gained many new

friends and customers; and walked with Mark Slagle as he battled an illness. In 2019, after Mark's passing, Ostrand Angus was blessed with the opportunity to purchase the remaining of the Slagle family's cows to carry on the Slagle Angus reputation.

Presently, the breeding program includes 500 registered Angus cows and

130 registered Angus bred heifers which all calve mid-December through February. Ostrand Angus puts great emphasis into their AI breeding program with some embryo transfer work. The cattle graze on owned and leased native grass. Other crops that are included in the operation are corn, alfalfa, cane, and irrigated grass. Presently, they hold their annual production sale on the third Wednesday in February at their ranch south of Ansley. They will market 160 yearling Angus bulls and 35 yearling replacement heifers. Private treaty bulls are also for sale late spring. The steer mates to the bulls are finished at the Ostrand ranch where they receive individual carcass data to reassure their cattle have superior carcass merit.

Kory and Danielle have four children. Their son, Brexton, is 11 years old. Twin girls, Avery & Olivia, are 9 years old. The youngest ranch hand, Merrik, is 5 years old. The children are great ranch hands and love being a part of the various ranch duties. Kory and Danielle love the teamwork that comes from running a registered cattle business together. From raising calves to chasing kids,

bull sale picture days to late night catalog proofing, recordkeeping to bull shopping, juggling children's activities to hours together chute side, from working in the sorting pen to the AI barn, and working in the hay field and silage field they find such joy in doing it together. To carry on the family ranching heritage, Kory partners with his father Neil, who runs the commercial cow herd. Also, Kory's aunt, Kathy Ostrand, his cousin Chris Hogg, and neighbor Chase help make the operation work. Ostrand Angus has helped their children each start their own registered Angus herd, which is laying the foundation for the 6th generation on the ranch. The children look forward to helping sell their own bulls each year on the production sale. The family has also found a passion for showing cattle at the country fair and have branched out to the Nebraska Junior Angus winter and state shows and hopefully will attend a national show in the future. When the cattle work is done, the family loves to go camping, run in a barrel race, or compete at a junior rodeo.

Kory, Danielle, and their family are humbled to accept the

Nebraska Producer of the Year award this year. A special thank you to the fellow Angus members and friends who have mentored Ostrand Angus and poured into their family. They look forward to continuing to serve the Angus breed and working with the best cattleman around, and plan to leave a legacy for the next generation.

61, of Ashby, Nebraska died
Tuesday, December 5, 2023, at
the University Nebraska Medical
Center in Omaha, Nebraska,
surrounded by family and friends.
Clint and his family lived 4 years and
4 months following a Stage 4
Esophageal cancer diagnosis.



Clint was born November 6, 1962, in Alliance, NE to Randall "Gene" Hebbert and Gail (Michel) Hebbert. He was a lifelong Sandhills resident, growing up in Ashby and attending elementary school, and graduating from Hyannis High School with the class of 1981. When Clint started school, he firmly told his family that he didn't need to go on the second day, because "he learned all he needed to know yesterday". He talked fondly about growing up in Ashby, running with "the gang of kids that were in the area, playing", sledding on the hill south of town, and hunting. He started summer work in the hayfield with his dad when he was six years old, and he and his brother Sid were working and helping at brandings by the time they were 10. He and Sid trapped muskrats in the winter to make money and cover whatever expenses that came around.

Following graduation from high school, he went to work for area ranchers, and got started in team roping when he worked for Joe Ferguson. In 1981 he won the Grant County Roping club year-end Header buckle, he continued team roping with area friends traveling all over Nebraska, whenever possible.

In 1984, he started working for the Nebraska Dept of Roads, as a maintenance worker, advancing to Maintenance crew chief out of the Hyannis yard. He worked for them for 24 years, leaving at the end of 2007 to realize his dream of ranching full time. He and his yard and crew were awarded "Yard of the Year" for District 6.

He met his wife Suzy (Kowalski) Hebbert, on a blind date in early 1991 and they were married on November 23, 1991. They celebrated 32 years of marriage on Thanksgiving this year. He started a "cattle partnership" with his brother Pat in 1989, then Clint and Suzy added registered Angus cattle in 1993, building their herd to its current level of 120 head of cows and heifers. In their early years, they marketed the seedstock by private treaty and finally moved to an "outdoor auction" in 2015. He and Suzy completed the Enhancing, Developing & Growing Entrepreneurs or "EDGE" business program offered by the University of Nebraska, winning second place statewide for their business program in 2001. They continued to expand their business and were recognized by the Nebraska Angus Association as their 2020 Nebraska Producers of the

Clint had a very strong work ethic, his motto was "If you're going to do something do it well and do it right"! If you're working on the highway, keep it in good shape for the safety of travelers, clear it of snow and ice, quickly and efficiently. When you fix fence, make the wires tight and evenly spaced, if you need to set a crooked post, you dig the post hole, so the post appears straight above ground. Take the initiative, if you see something that needs to be done, do it, don't wait for someone to tell you to do it. Maintain your vehicles and equipment and they will last longer.


Family and friends were important to him. He treasured the time spent growing up with his cousins and friends who were like family. He instilled in his sons that education was important, especially their education outside the classroom, and to be a lifelong learner. He was his wife's Mr. Fixit, doing the household repair tasks, maintaining their vehicles and lawn equipment. He installed many of the appliances in their home and even did the plumbing on their addition to their house. If he wasn't "sure" exactly how to do a repair, Google® and YouTube® were his go to reference manuals. He figured out he


could use game trail cameras with cellular signals to keep track of the water level in his stock tanks in the cattle pastures. It wasn't easy for him to accept offers of help, but if he saw someone else who needed a helping hand, he was usually one of the first ones to show up. Some of his most treasured life events included watching his sons graduate from their post-secondary education programs and walking his daughter-in-law Kate down the aisle on her wedding day to Ed.

He had many hobbies including watching rodeos and he was an avid Husker football and volleyball fan. He knew when all the local high school games were on tap, and he enjoyed cheering for his sons and the children of friends. He enjoyed finding the latest gadgets to use on the ranch such as cameras on the bale bed pickup or the latest Milwaukee battery powered tool. He truly enjoyed attending gun shows. The most important "hobby" was helping his neighbors and friends by being a true Sandhills rancher. Clint was a good teacher, he taught his sons about everything from cattle ranching, to trapshooting, to work hard but also to find time to enjoy the little things in life, like cinnamon bears. Clint was an active member of the Ashby C.A.V.E (aka Citizens Against Virtually Everything) and always had an opinion at the meetings. He enjoyed living and being from the Sandhills and that way of life. As some people would say he is a rock solid Sandhiller. Hard to find a Sandhills community member that he couldn't strike up a conversation with. Sometimes just checking the cattle would turn into an all-day "chore" because we found someone to visit with along the way.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and his grandparents; Albert and Ima Hebbert; and Louis and Ethel Michel. His brother Pat, and father-inlaw John Kowalski.

Clint is survived by his wife Suzy, of Ashby, NE. His sons Ed (Kate) of Grafton, NE and Joe (Makala) of Stuart, NE; his sister; Betty Jo (Jim) Leapley, of Coleridge, NE; his brother; Mike "Sid" (Vicki) Hebbert, of Prescott, AZ; Mother-in-law Eileen Kowalski of St. Paul, NE; brothers and sisters-laws Steve (Kay) Kowalski of Custer, SD and Sam (Carol) Kowalski of Virginia Beach, VA. Aunts and Uncles, numerous nieces and nephews; and





several great nieces and nephews, cousins and a very large circle of friends, and his faithful service dog, Will.

While Clint lived the last few years of his life battling with cancer that eventually consumed his earthly body, we all won because he lived with courage, humor, hard work, dignity, and a zest for life.

Funeral Services were held Sunday, December 10, 2023, at 2:00 pm MT in the Lecture Hall at the Hyannis High School in Hyannis, NE. Burial was in the Ashby Cemetery. Memorials are suggested to the Grant County Rescue Unit Fund, PO Box 164, Hyannis, NE 69350, or the Family in care of Suzy Hebbert, 905 Railroad Dr, Ashby, NE 69333.

From the start of their operations, these individuals set out on a mission to improve the Angus breed and




the cattle industry. Each remained resilient while navigating the ever-changing beef industry and its challenges.




